GENERAL RULES

- 1. Entry into school is not permitted after decided timing in the morning.
- 2. A minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory to be eligible to appear in the examination.
- 3. Students must come to school in neatly waste iron/laundered uniform only.

- 5. In the event of damaging School property, the responsible student will be charged the cost of damage.
- 6. Students are not allowed to leave the class without class out pass and without permission of the teacher.

- 8. Students must bring books/notebooks according to the time table and based on instruction given by the teacher.

- 10. Parents must inform that the class teacher and principal at the time of admission about the word if he/she is having any health issue so that precaution can be taken.

PROHIBITED BEHAVIOR

- 1. Regular attendance unjustified or unexplained absence habitual late coming, leaving the school premises without permission, disorders any type of unruly and objectionable behavior.
- 2. Writing, scratching engraving, grafting, drawing, splashing ink or defacing the school walls, furniture and property.

- 3. Glowing stickers and posters of any kind on the school property.
- 4. Use of fall and unparliamentarily language.
- 5. Neglect of homework, disorders and disrespectful two words member of staff or bad moral influence.
- 6. Resources of use of unfair means during examinations.
- 7. Participating in any incident of bullying and ragging.
- 8. Collecting money, contribution and donation without return Permission of the principal.

FREE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. Fee to be paid on or before 15th of the month. Parents who are irregular in paying fee are liable to a fine of rupees 10 per day for 1 month only (T&C)
